1. The online catalog called IUCAT will be converted to a web-based catalog during the semester break in December. The current catalog will be frozen on October 22 (no new items will be added). The new catalog is scheduled for implementation on January 2, 2001.
2. The proposal for a \$10 million addition to the library building will go to the legislature in the spring.
3. The grand opening of the Science Information Center will be November 8.
4. The librarians are preparing a resolution on information literacy that will come to the library subcommittee in October.

The subcommittee's resolution regarding copyright and electronic reserves and coursepaks requires action. J. Violette will distribute copies and fair use guidelines prior to the next meeting.
